Early Canadian Metis

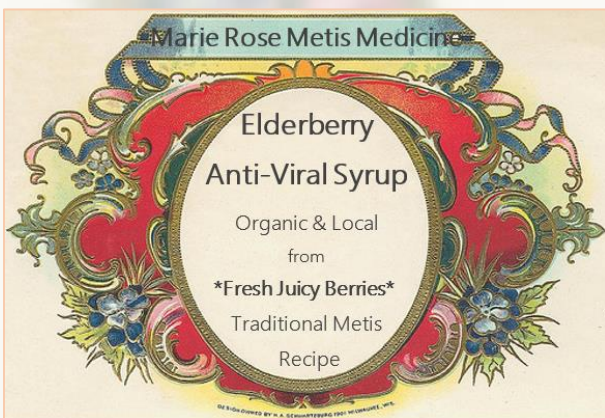
Healer & Midwife



My Grandmother's Grandmother was a Healer and Midwife in the 1800's. She lived a traditional Metis lifestyle, travelling in her father's trade caravan until she was sold for \$50 to a fur trader to be his bride. Together, they founded the Jughandle Ranch on Pincher Creek.

Marie Rose raised 17 children and became an author and historian, preserving the traditional knowledge and experiences of her 98 years of prairie life for generations of Albertans to come.
